

Introduction

This document will cover installation, usage, and general knowledge of the Passenger2 Companion Tool.

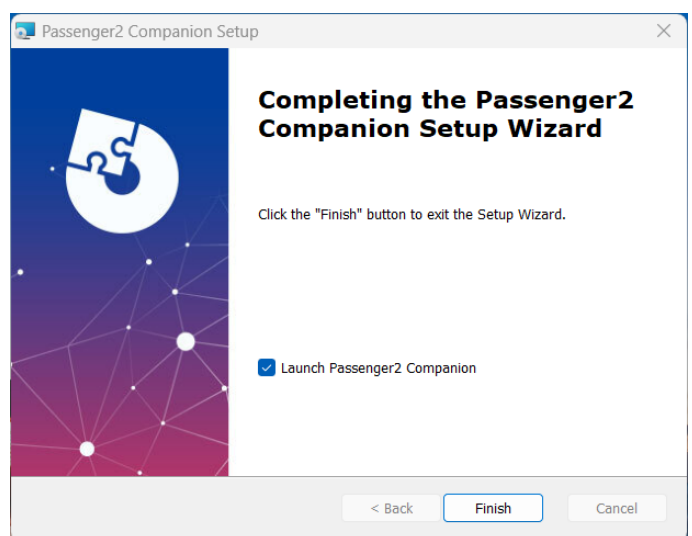
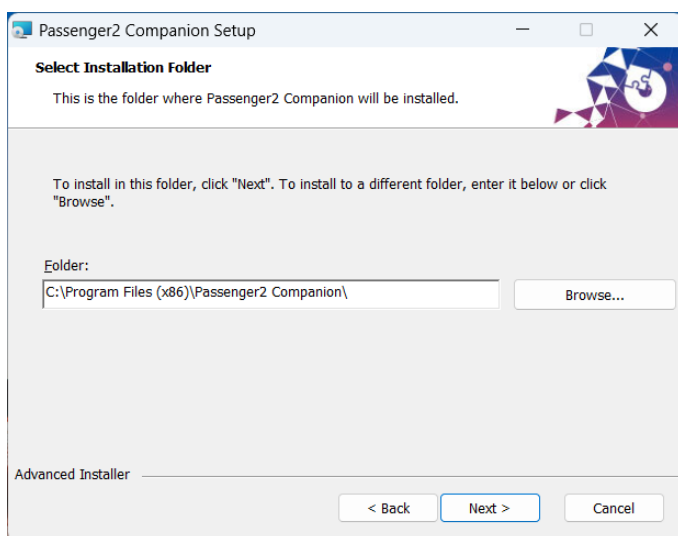
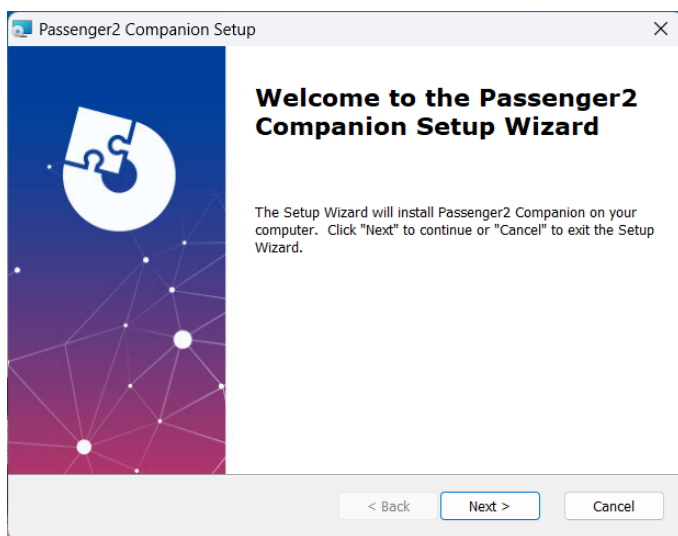
This tool has been designed to help you create custom sound packs without editing any files.

Installation

The Passenger2 installer (pictured below) will install the application.

IMPORTANT

- Please run the installer and application as an administrator.
- If you experience any issues with the application launching or if Windows Defender prompts you, you will need to add the Passenger2 Companion application as an exception.



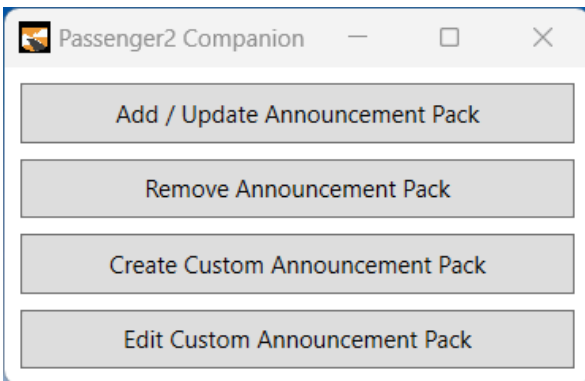

Getting Started

Once installed, click the “Passenger2 Companion” icon pictured below, which should be located on your desktop.



Once opened, you will be presented with the main interface. We will explain each menu in this manual.



IMPORTANT

Never have Passenger2 open whilst changing, adding, and/or removing announcements.

Add / Update Announcement Pack

Select this option if you are adding a pre-made announcement pack.

You can view the announcement packs available on our website [HERE](#).

Note: You will need to log in to download the announcement packs. If you do not already have an account, you can create one for free.

Simply download your chosen sound pack, select "Add / Update Announcement Pack," select your downloaded ZIP folder, click "Open," and you will receive a message advising that it has been installed successfully.

There is no need to unzip the file before adding it.

You can also use this option if the pack you are using needs to be updated, and it has the same folder name.

You can then select your announcement pack from the flight setup screen, or if you are a Passenger2 Pro user, you can set it as default within the company manager.

Remove Announcement Pack


If you no longer wish to have a particular sound pack installed, select this option.

Click “Remove Announcement Pack,” then navigate to **Documents\Passenger2\Announcements** and select the folder you wish to remove. The announcement pack will be removed from the folder and your config file automatically.

Create Custom Announcement Pack

This option allows you to create your own announcement pack by fully customising all the sounds you might hear within Passenger2.



The options you can choose are:

Captain Announcements

You can customise your captain announcements by either leaving them as default or selecting a sound file. If you choose "Default," this will use the language setting you have configured within Passenger2 Settings.

Flight Attendant Announcements

You can either choose your own custom sound file or set a particular language. You can also opt to have different male and female voices for different announcements.

IMPORTANT – Using a custom sound file?

If you want to use your custom files, it **must** be in .OGG format.

Please follow these instructions:

1. Click on “Create Custom Announcement Pack” on the Passenger2 companion screen.
2. Choose your preferred announcement options.
3. When ready, click “CREATE”.
4. Navigate to **C:\Users\YOUR-NAME\Documents\Passenger2\Announcements** and click “Select Folder”. Then choose “OK”.
5. Now click “Add / Update Announcement Pack,” go to your new announcement folder, select the .zip file, click “Open,” and your new pack will be automatically installed.
6. Select your new pack during flight setup, or if you are a Passenger2 Pro user, you can set this as a permanent announcement pack on your company settings page.



Edit Custom Announcement Pack

If you have created a sound pack using the Passenger2 companion tool, choose this option to edit any announcements.

Note: Do **not** use this option if you have downloaded an announcement pack from the Passenger2 website. This option is only for packs you have created using this tool.

If you want to edit a custom announcement pack already created, follow the instructions below:

1. Click "Edit Custom Announcement Pack."
2. Go to **C:\Users\YOUR-NAME\Documents\Passenger2\Announcements**.
3. Select the title of the folder your custom pack is in and click "Open."
4. Edit your announcement settings
5. Click "Save," and a message will confirm that the settings have been changed.
6. Click on "Add/Update" on the Passenger2 companion screen.
7. Navigate to **C:\Users\YOUR-NAME\Documents\Passenger2\Announcements**, select the .zip file of the announcement folder you have just edited, click "Open," and your new pack will be automatically installed.
8. Select your new pack during flight setup, or if you are a Passenger2 Pro user, you can set this as a permanent announcement pack on your company settings page.
